Installation Tips

Before you begin installing these sport bar covers, read all instructions thoroughly. Below are a few tips to make this installation easier.

For a smooth fit:


For ease in installation, the sport bar covers should be installed at temperatures above 72° F. Below this temperature, the fabric may contract an inch or more, making it difficult to fit to the vehicle.


It is normal for the fabric to contract and wrinkle when stored in the shipping carton. Within a few days after the installation, the fabric will relax and the wrinkles will disappear.

IF YOUR VEHICLE HAS A SOUND BAR


It may be easier to install the Center Sport Bar Cover if you loosen the bolts that secure the Sound Bar and move it to allow access to the rear of the Center Sport Bar. Once the Center Sport Bar Cover is installed the Sound Bar can be re-secured.







Step Two

The installation of the Sport Bar Covers will be easier if the door molding is removed. To remove the door molding, unscrew the knobs above the door opening and lift the molding off of the vehicle.








Step Seven

Wrap the bottom part of the cover around the bar, under the seat belts and bows and fasten the loop sewn along the top to the hook strips on the bottom of the upper section. Start the zipper at the bottom of the cover and close it up to the Seat Belt Adjustment Mount.

If necessary, readjust the hook and loop on the Seat Belt Adjustment Mount for a smooth fit.

Passenger Side




Step Eight

Close the Center Zipper across the top of the cover and repeat Steps Five through Seven on the other side of the vehicle.

Step Nine (soft top only)

Re-Install the Side Bow Pivot Knuckles onto the upper flange of the Pivot Bracket. Align the knuckle with the bracket and it will snap into place on the bracket. Install a Pivot Knuckle Screw and tighten with T-30 Torx driver.


Re-Install the Rear Bow Pivot Knuckle Assemblies onto the lower flange of the Pivot Bracket. Make sure that the holes in the Pivot Knuckles are facing the outside of the vehicle. Align the knuckle with the bracket and it will snap into place on the bracket. Install a Pivot Knuckle Screw and tighten with T-30 Torx driver.



IF YOU LOOSENED YOUR SOUND BAR


to install the Center Sport Bar Cover, re-secure the Sound Bar when you have completed Step Seven.






Step Ten


Locate the Left and Right Rear Sport Bar Cover and the Left and Right Rear Bar Foam in the parts kit. Lay the fabric as flat as possible on a clean surface with the backing side up and lay the matching foam piece on top with the adhesive strip down. When you have determined the proper position of the foam, remove the protective strip and attach the foam to the fabric with the adhesive strip.





Step Eleven

Drape the cover over the Rear Sport Bar and fit the curve in the fabric over the curve in the bar.




Step Thirteen

Repeat Steps Ten through Twelve on the other side of the vehicle.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A SOUND BAR

Locate the Rear Sport Bar Extension Foam pieces and the Rear Sport Bar Extensions in the parts kit. These will be small rectangular pieces. Lay the fabric out as flat as possible on a clean surface with the backing side up. When the proper position is determined, remove the protective strip from the back of the foam and press the adhesive strip on the foam to the fabric.


These will fill in the space where the Sound Bar would sit over the Rear Sport Bars. Open the zipper on the Rear Sport Bar Cover a few inches and wrap the extension around the bar so that the hook and loop edges fasten to each other along the bottom of the bar. Close the Rear Sport Bar Cover so that it overlaps the Rear Sport Bar Extension.



Step Fourteen


Locate a Horizontal Bar Cover in the parts kit and orient it with the openings in the cover over the mounting holes for the Door Surround. Wrap the cover around the bar and close the zipper from front to back. Slide the cover around the bar so that the zipper is along the inside of the bar and the openings are clear to accept the Door Surround.

Repeat this procedure on the other side of the vehicle.



Step Fifteen (soft top only)

Re-install the left and right Door Surrounds. Insert the pin in the bottom of the Door Surround into the hole in the belt rail behind the door. Press the channels along the top of the Door Surround around the horizontal sport bar, above the door opening. Insert two knobs into the Door Surround and tighten them down.



Care and Maintenance of your Sport Bar Covers


Your covers are made of the finest materials available. To keep them looking new and for the maximum possible wear, it will need periodic cleaning and maintenance.

Washing: The <u>fabric</u> should be washed often using soap, warm water and a soft bristle brush. Rinse with clear water to remove all traces of soap.

Zippers: Keeping the zipper cleaned and lubricated with a silicone lubricant will help prevent damage and keep the zippers in a smooth working condition. If a zipper opens behind the slider, the slider may have been spread apart.

This problem can usually be repaired by using

This problem can usually be repaired by using an ordinary pair of pliers to bring the sides back into parallel. Return slider to the end of the zipper in the normal Open position. Squeeze lightly at first and test the zipper. If the zipper continues to remain open squeeze more firmly with the pliers and try the zipper again. Repeat this procedure until the zipper operates correctly.

Water: In the event of seeping through the seams, 3M Scotchgard® may be applied on the inside of the seams to stop the seepage. Rips in the fabric may be repaired with Bondex® iron on patches. Iron the patches to the Inside of the top, carefully following the Bondex® instructions.

Snaps: Keep snaps cleaned and lubricated with silicone to help prevent snaps from sticking to the studs. If a snap does become stuck to a stud, use a screwdriver and GENTLY pry apart to prevent permanent damage to the snap or the top fabric.
